



## Bay View Boat Club

### NOTICE OF RACE Midwinter Madness 2018-2019

**1) RULES:** The races shall be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including the prescriptions of the USSA, as modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2) ELEGIBILITY and ENTRY:** Any sailing craft. All entries must be received at the club before the start of the race.

**3) FEES:**

No fee.

**4) SCHEDULE:** There will be one race per day. Warning for first race shall be 1300. No race will start after 1400. Race dates will be: 11/10/16 12/8/1 01/12/17 02/9/17 03/9/17. Entry fee is \$5.00 per race.

**5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the BVBC and on [bvbc.org](http://bvbc.org) no later than 18:00 on the Monday before the series begins.

**6) SAILING AREA:** The sailing area shall be between SF Pier 54 and Alameda NAS #2. Starts shall be signaled from on the water near the Start area.

**7) HANDICAPS:** Handicaps are the same as those of SF Bay YRA PHRF when known for a sailing craft or a Handicap assigned by the Race Committee. In case of question, the decision of the RC Chairman will prevail. If there is any further dispute, a current SF Bay YRA PHRF must be filed for the boat (not "class") in question. The current PHRF certificate will be the rating used. The race will be scored on Time-on-Distance.

**8) Time Allowances:** There will be an 6 Sec. per NM Time Allowance for Non Spinnaker and a 9 Sec. per NM allowance for Single Handing (no crew). Any yachts wishing a time allowance must state so on their Application for Race Entry. The time allowance shall not be changed after a vessel sails under it for one race.

**9) DIVISIONS -** There will be one division

**10) SCORING:** There will be one throw out per series.

**11) AWARDS:** There will be daily (liquid) trophies for each day of racing (think beer). Series trophies will be awarded at the clubhouse after the last race on March 9th 2019.

**12) WEATHER CHECKS:** In extreme weather the race will be canceled. Skippers must use their own judgment.
